PROJECTS WE ARE CURRENTLY PROMOTING...

COMMUNITY SANITATION PROJECT: (Project #221)

Toilets are needed in a village area where a new school called 5 Star Kinder Care Church of God N/P is being developed in Kamuli district in the town of Buwenge.

Because the school shifted from the rental area to their own plot of land, there are no toilets presently. The school will need to start with having to use the neighbour's toilets for a small fee payment for the usage. The toilets are the greatest need amongst many. The plan is to begin with nursery and three primary grades. The school is estimating a start-up of 100 children.

RELIEF PROJECT—ROOF REPAIR (Disaster Relief #223)

The project over all purpose is to provide relief for the needs of a community through restoration of a community building that will serve as a church, a school and tailoring center.

This is a labor project to provide funds to **rebuild a roof that was destroyed by a storm.**

The church building is located in Katakwi district in the outskirts of a town. The community uses it for meetings, gatherings, and for children coming for choir. There are plans to include a tailoring center in the building to train young people needing to develop job skills to provide a living for themselves.

The cost of the roof with timbers and a metal roof of iron sheets is estimated to be \$5,000. Local builders would be contracted to build it, giving them a livelihood to be able to support their families. This would give a much needed boost to the people in the community bringing them hope and excitement. Seeing a church repaired and developed for several uses, creates a sense of permanence, and vision. The tailoring school would also be a permanent place for the young adults to come to and be sheltered and comfortable and increase the potential of the neighbourhood.
